FOR WOMEN AND INDIVIDUALS WHO IDENTIFY AS WOMEN

**PURPOSE:**

CFUW Southport is pleased to offer a scholarship in the amount of **\$1000.00** to be granted to a woman, or individual who identifies as a woman, who is pursuing post-secondary education and/or training, or an apprenticeship program to prepare for a career in the Skilled Trades.

**DEFINITION:** A **Skilled Trade** is an occupation that requires a particular skill set, knowledge, or ability. **CRITERIA:**

- Applicant is a woman, or individual who identifies as a woman.
- Applicant is a resident of Bruce County and/or Saugeen First Nation #29.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to, or ongoing enrollment in, a post-secondary program to pursue education, training or apprenticeship leading to a career in \*Skilled Trades.

**APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- A letter (maximum 500 words) that includes:
  - Name, address, telephone number, email address.
  - Description and reasons why they should receive the scholarship, and their aspirations for the future.
- Name and contact information of a personal reference
- Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary educational program leading to a career in \*Skilled Trades
- **Note:** Applicant must participate in an interview in-person or via video call with members of the CFUW Southport Scholarship Committee.
- Application deadline: **May 15, 2026.**
