

# Community Bulky Waste Collection & Guidelines



**MAY 16-18 | BULKY WASTE TO THE ROAD**  
**MAY 19 | BULKY WASTE COLLECTED**

- Place items at the roadside in the evening before collection
- Do not block roads or driveways
- Keep items separated from regular garbage
- Stack items safely to prevent hazards
- Items must be manageable for lifting by waste staff
- Sharp objects must be wrapped
- Heavy items may require two-person handling



This event is intended to support responsible disposal. Residents are encouraged to use this opportunity properly so the program can continue annually.

<b>Furniture</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Sofas and couches</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Chairs and recliners</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Tables and desks</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Bed frames</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Dressers and cabinets</li></ul>
<b>Household Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Mattresses and box springs</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Carpets and rugs (rolled and tied)</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Large plastic items</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Broken shelves</li></ul>
<b>Appliances (non-hazardous)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Washing machines</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Dryers</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Stoves</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Fridge</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Dishwashers</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Microwaves</li></ul>
<b>Metal &amp; Scrap Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Bicycles</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Metal frames</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Non-hazardous scrap metal</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Trailers must be <b>dismantled</b> into manageable size or simply tow it to the landfill site yourself at no disposal fee</li></ul>

<b>Outdoor Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Lawn furniture</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Fencing material (cut into manageable sections)</li></ul>
<b>Electronic Waste</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Televisions</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Computers</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Monitors</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Printers</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Other large electronics not mentioned</li></ul>
<b>Automotive Waste</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Car tires</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Car parts (parts must be dismantled)</li></ul>

# Community Bulky Waste Collection & Guidelines



## UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS (will not be collected)

<b>Regular Household Garbage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Bagged garbage that fits into regular bins</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Food waste</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Everyday household trash</li></ul>
<b>Hazardous Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Paint</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Chemicals</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Fuel containers</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Pesticides</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Propane tanks</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Batteries</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Waste hydraulic fluid (engine oil etc.)</li></ul> <p><i>* These can be brought to the landfill site for collection</i></p>
<b>Construction Waste</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Concrete</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Bricks</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Roofing shingles</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Large amounts of wood</li><li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Dry walls and insulators</li></ul> <p><i>* The contractor who performed the renovation is responsible for collecting and disposing at the landfill at no fee</i></p>
